Officers' Reports

CJAC (Marvin Hernandez)

- Watch language – league will be suspending play for inappropriate language – to players or refs

Finance (Phil Ziegler)

- Reviews mid-year Profit and Loss (handout)
 - Labor (ref assignor and ref fees) is one of largest components of budget (not reflected on handout)
- Fall Budget – per player fee based on individual projected for fall
- Player insurance (1st column) now under State Registration (2nd column)
- Players on multiple teams will not play same fee for all teams
- Base Team Fee \$80 per player + \$20 state registration fee + \$5 Demosphere = \$105
- \$65 for second team (see handouts for additional figures)
- As mentioned last meeting, overall team fee was projected for this season
- Questions result in tabling discussion until full payment discussion later in meeting
 - Questions include half season players; players who don't pay; surplus amounts
 - Players in multiple *leagues* DO pay multiple state association fees (not an NVASA issue)

Scheduler (Sharon)

- Please call Sharon (703) 587-5866 when there is a field issue at game time
- There is a league that is abusing their slots by not using them; we Really need field monitors
- Please be specific about fields you Cannot play on – telling what season
- Forfeits and reschedules – much better than this season – thank you! Please give at least 48 hrs. notice!
- Remember – one “freebie” forfeit, then you are charge
- Aug. 15th is start date; if you can play earlier, please let Sharon know; she cannot start teams later than that
- Lou – a reschedule requires 3 parties – both teams and scheduler

Secretary (Sarah)

- Facebook pics are up on NVASA page! They go back to 2005 – please check them out, add your own

Commissioner (Lou)

- **Sharing Players** - In D2, there was conflict every time trying to arrange red/blue “conferences.” PLEASE be cautious when sharing players – we cannot accommodate everyone's conflicts

- **Equipment** – several nets, etc. have been stolen. Do we: keep using boxes (we have to remember to lock the box!) or let county put the nets up (if they are stolen, we have to buy replacements). Suggestions are taken.
- **Referees** - working with JP on ref mentoring, etc.
- **New United Rep** - 2 players from each team (one male and one female); 8 teams will play – we will have RFK Aux. Fields from 8am to 6pm!
- Keepers and captains will be picked by officers
- Cost of doing business does not allow for splitting a fee between two people

Registrar (Babette)

- **New Per Player Payment System:**
 - System will eliminate:
 - illegal players/ people who never pay, and then play
 - players who try to register for tournaments without having paid us
 - Babette shows two handouts to introduce system
 - Captains will have to collect player info
 - PLEASE tell new players your team name!
 - Players will only pay state association once year
 - New players still have to have info entered into website
 - Babette's transition time is between 3-6pm – she is not available online
 - **Player Pool** – once a player is approved, they will not be taken off of a team's pool
 - Everything has been wiped out for new system – all players will have to be entered once
 - **Team caps** – should cap at 30 players (please)
 - **Payment Deadlines** – at least 15 players must be registered and paid by the end of this week in order to be able to play (this season only)
 - **Late Additions** - we are considering partial payments to deal with late additions/ injury replacements, etc.
 - **Subs** – teams will be allowed subs without needing payment
 - **Babette will send this system (handouts) out by e-mail for review**
